Additional Overtime for KLWTD employees working during the November 2023 No-Name rain event/storm and the after-effects on the KLWTD Wastewater System:

KLWTD's General Manager has approved the following:

- The District is going to compensate employees for overtime worked at the rate of double your normal hourly rate. This will be for storm related work performed outside of normal work week hours from:
 - o Wednesday Nov. 15 through Friday Nov. 17;
 - o Saturday Nov 18 to Sunday Nov 19; (all hours on the weekend)
 - o Monday Nov. 20 (outside of normal work week hours)
- This additional overtime will allow employees who worked overtime during the storm to receive a total of 2 times (double) overtime rate. The original time and a half, or 1.5 rate, was previously paid on the 11/24/23 and 12/1/23 paychecks.

WHEREAS, Island Construction Management, Inc., has submitted an application to the Monroe County Board of County Commissioners for abandonment of a portion of the right-of-way of Hibiscus Street contiguous to Lots 20 and 23, OCEAN ACRES subdivision; and

WHEREAS, Island Construction Management, Inc., has requested that the District deliver a Letter of No Objection to the application; and

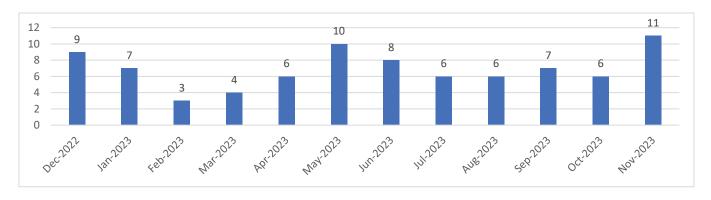
