Wastewater Field Operations

There were a total of 25 service calls for the month of September of these 14 were system-generated alarms, mostly by low vacuum detection at a vacuum station. The system-generated alarms were addressed quickly by the field staff 9 of those systems generated were found using the **(FVMS) Flo Vac Monitoring System**. The reports below detail the remaining 11 calls from customers.




Daily Flow (MGD)

The daily peak salinity for the current month.






Figure 3: Pump diagnosis and repair




Figure 11: Spare sewage pump volute and pump base being lowered into tank vault

The General Manager and/or his designee(s) are authorized to take all actions necessary to implement the terms and conditions of this Resolution.


