What impressed me even more, however, wasn't just their individual efforts—it was the culture they have helped create.

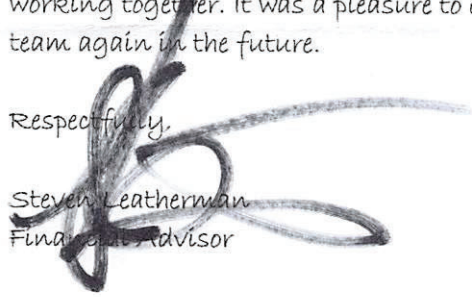
